ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

**TEMPORARY “AT ANY TIME” PARKING, WAITING AND LOADING
RESTRICTIONS HARBOROUGH ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable maintenance and repair works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from parking and waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle) at any time in that length of Harborough Road (both sides) which lies between Nos. 102/104 Harborough Road and Nos. 126/128 Harborough Road.
2. The ban on parking and waiting by vehicles would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
3. The Order would come into force on 14th February 2021 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be carried out on 14th February 2021 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed in that time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days and dates up to the maximum period of 1 month.
