TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - TRINITY RISE

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable works to be carried out to replace a gas main, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Trinity Rise which lies between the western kerb-line of Norwood Road and a point 15 metres west of that kerb-line.
- 2. Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the road closure described above would be available via Norwood Road and Brockwell Park Gardens and vice versa.
- 3. The road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 4th January 2021 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 12 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect for about 4 weeks but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at a subsequent time or times within the maximum duration of 12 months.
