ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE ULLSWATER ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable SGN to carry out gas main replacement works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intends to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Ullswater Road which lies between Norwood Road and a point 35 metres south-west of Norwood Road.
2. Alternative routes for vehicles would be available for affected vehicles via Ullswater Road, Harpenden Road, York Hill and Norwood Road and vice versa.
3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order would come into force on 11th January 2021 and would continue in force for a maximum duration of 6 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be carried out between 11th January and 28th March 2021, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed in that time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days up to the maximum period of 6 months.
