ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – LANCASTER AVENUE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable works to be carried out to replace a gas main, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Lancaster Avenue which lies between its junction with Norwood Road and the western kerb-line of Dalton Street.
2. Alternative routes would be available as follows -
 - (a) for HGVs, and other vehicles the height of which exceeds 4.1 metres (13 feet 6 inches): via Norwood Road, Half Moon Lane, Herne Hill, Denmark Hill, Champion Park, Grove Lane, Dog Kennel Hill, Grove Vale, Dulwich Common and Thurlow Park Road, and vice versa; and
 - (b) for lighter vehicles: via Norwood Road, Norwood High Street, Elder Road, Central Hill, Westow Hill, Crystal Palace Parade, College Road, Dulwich Wood Park, South Croxted Road, Croxted Road and Thurlow Park Road, and vice versa except that vehicles on Norwood High Street would continue towards Norwood Road via Ernest Avenue and Knight's Hill.
3. The road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order would come into force on 13th February 2021 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect for about 1-2 weeks but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at a subsequent time or times within the maximum duration of 3 months.
