ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 16A

**TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF PEDESTRIAN AND VEHICULAR TRAFFIC
FOR FILMING IN BRAD STREET, ROUPELL STREET AND THEED STREET**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable filming to take place in Brad Street, Roupell Street and Theed Street the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles and pedestrians from entering:-

- (a) Brad Street, so much as is public highway;
- (b) Roupell Street, between Cornwall Road and the party wall of Nos. 6 and 7 Roupell Street;
- (c) Theed Street, between the south-eastern kerb-line of Whittlesey Street and the north-western kerb-line of Roupell Street.

2. Alternative routes for vehicles and pedestrians affected by the road closures described above would be available via adjacent streets as directed by traffic signs.

(In practice it is anticipated that filming would be intermittent, so pedestrian access to and from premises in the above roads would be maintained outside filming)

3. Whenever the ban referred to in paragraph 1(b) applies the one-way systems for vehicles in Roupell Street would be suspended.

4. The bans would only have effect at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs and they would not apply to any vehicle or person connected with the filming.

5. The Order would come into force on 4th March 2021 and would continue in force for a maximum duration of 2 days.
