ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14

**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE AND ONE-WAY SYSTEM
– LEIGHAM VALE**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable water main repair works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to:-
 - (a) temporarily ban vehicles from entering the southbound section of road in that length of Leigham Vale which lies between its junction with Knollys Road and its junction with Stockfield Road;
 - (b) introduce a one-way system in that length of Leigham Vale which lies between its junction with Knollys Road and its junction with Stockfield Road, operating in a south-east to north-west direction.
2. The road closure and one-way system would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
3. An alternative route for affected vehicles would be available via Leigham Vale, Stockfield Road, Mount Nod Road, Leigham Court Road and Knollys Road.
4. The Order would come into force on 8th March 2021 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect between 8th and 10th March 2021 inclusive, but if the works cannot be carried out or be completed during that time then the Order may have effect on a subsequent day or days within the maximum duration of 2 months.
