ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – NURSERY ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable telecommunications works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Nursery Road which lies between Shannon Grove and No. 53 Nursery Road.
2. The road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via (i) Ferndale Road, Pulross Road, Bellefields Road, Stockwell Road, Stockwell Park Walk, Brixton Road, Effra Road, St Matthews Road, Brixton Hill, Brixton Road, Brighton Terrace, Bernay's Grove, Tunstall Road and Shannon Grove; and (ii) Shannon Grove, Tunstall Road, Bernay's Grove, Brighton Terrace, Brixton Road and Ferndale Road.
4. The Order would come into force on 21st March 2021 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect on 21st March 2021 for one day, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed on that day the Order may have effect on a subsequent day or days within the maximum duration of 1 month.
