ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(2)

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES – WANDSWORTH ROAD AND LAVENDER HILL

1. The Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, with the agreement of the Council of the London Borough of Wandsworth, HEREBY GIVES NOTICE under section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 that from 26th February 2021 for up to 5 days, vehicles will be temporarily banned from entering:-

- (a) the length of Wandsworth Road which lies between its junction with Cedars Road and Queenstown Road and the west side of Victoria Rise; and
- (b) the length of Lavender Hill which lies between its junction with Cedars Road and Queenstown Road and the common boundary of Nos. 8 and 10 Lavender Hill.

2. The road closures described above would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs. It is anticipated that the works will be carried out over two nights from approximately 21.00 hours until approximately 05.00 hours.

3. Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the road closures would be available via adjacent roads as indicated by traffic signs.

4. It is necessary for the road closures to come into force without delay so that emergency works can be carried out to survey and repair defective infrastructure within the central areas of the Wandsworth Road/Queenstown Road/Cedars Road/Lavender Hill junction.
