

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – BARRHILL ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable works involving the operation of a crane to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering Barrhill Road.
2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via -
 - (a) Streatham Hill, Telford Avenue and Blairderry Road and vice versa; and
 - (b) Streatham Hill, Ardwell Road and Blairderry Road and vice versa.
3. The road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order would come into force on 20th April 2021 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would be carried out on 20th April 2021 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed in that time then the Order may have effect on a subsequent day or days, during the maximum period of 2 months.
