ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE HARPENDEN ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Harpenden Road which lies between the south-western kerb-line of Norwood Road and a point 10 metres south-west of Norwood Road.
2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Harpenden Road, Ulverstone Road, Ullswater Road, Norwood Road and vice versa.
3. The road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The order would come into force on 19th May 2021 and would continue for a maximum duration of 12 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect at night on 19th May 2021 between 11pm and 4am and at night on 15th February 2022 between 11pm and 4am, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order would also have effect on subsequent dates.
