

**LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES – GREENHURST ROAD, KINGSCOURT ROAD AND ST JULIAN'S FARM ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable water main repair works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of:-

- (a) Greenhurst Road, which lies between No. 9 Greenhurst Road and No. 19 Greenhurst Road (alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Cheviot Road and Lamberhurst Road and vice versa);
- (b) Kingscourt Road, which lies between No. 55 Kingscourt Road and No. 67 Kingscourt Road (an alternative route for affected vehicles would be available via Streatham High Road, Norfolk House Road and Mount Ephraim Lane);
- (c) St Julian's Farm Road, which lies between No. 71 St Julian's Farm Road and No. 79 St Julian's Farm Road (alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Thurlestone Road, Wolfington Road, Casewick Road and Vic versa).

2 The above road closures would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. The Order would come into force on 26<sup>th</sup> April 2021 and would continue in force for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingences) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be carried out between 26<sup>th</sup> April 2021 and 28<sup>th</sup> May 2021 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed in that time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days up to the maximum period of 2 months.
