ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE WALCOT SQUARE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable new sewer connection works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Walcot Square which lies:
 - (a) between the eastern kerb-line of Kennington Road and the common boundary of Nos. 8 and 10 Walcot Square; and
 - (b) between the western kerb-line of Walcot Square (north to south arm) and the north-western extremity of Walcot Square (north-west to south-east arm).
2. The road closures would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Walcot Square, Bishop's Terrace, Kennington Road and vice versa.
4. The Order would come into force on 24th May 2021 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect from 24th May to 2nd June 2021, but if the works cannot be carried out or be completed during that time then the Order may have effect on a subsequent day or days within the maximum duration of 2 months.
