ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – ELM PARK

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable Thames Water to carry out sewer repair works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Elm Park which lies between No. 60 Elm Park and No. 85 Elm Park.
2. Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the above road closure would be available via:
 - (a) Elm Park, Leander Road, Medora Road, Craster Road, Elm Park and vice versa; and
 - (b) Elm Park, Ostade Road, Upper Tulse Hill, Brixton Hill, Elm Park and vice versa.
3. The road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing or covering of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order would come into force on 28th June 2021 and it would continue in force for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner.
