ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14

**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES – BLENHEIM GARDENS, DORCHESTER DRIVE, ELMS CRESCENT,
MILKWOOD ROAD, PRENTIS ROAD AND VASSALL ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable highway improvement works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intends to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering:-
 - (a) Blenheim Gardens;
 - (b) Dorchester Drive;
 - (c) Elms Crescent;
 - (d) Milkwood Road;
 - (e) Prentis Road; and
 - (f) Vassall Road.
2. Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the closure of the above roads would be available via adjacent roads as indicated by traffic signs, and exemptions would apply for vehicles gaining access to or egress from properties in, or accessible only from, those roads as far as the extent of the works permits that.
3. The road closures described above would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order would come into force on 28th February 2020 and continue for a maximum duration of 12 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner.
