ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – BRAXTED PARK

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable telecommunication maintenance and repair works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Braxted Park which lies between Baldry Gardens and Nos. 14 and 16 Braxted Park.
2. The above road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Streatham Common South, Copley Park and Baldry Gardens and vice versa.
4. The Order would come into force on 27th September 2021 and would continue in force for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect from 27th September 2021 for 3 days but if the works cannot be carried out or completed in that time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days and dates up to the maximum period of 2 months.
