**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS – HEATHDENE ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable Telecommunication maintenance and repair works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, subject to the agreement of Transport for London, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering or waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading and unloading a vehicle) in that length of Heathdene Road which lies between Streatham High Road and No. 44 Heathdene Road.
2. Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the above road closure would be available via Streatham High Road, Hilldown Road and Fontaine Road and vice versa.
3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing or covering of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order would come into force on 11<sup>th</sup> November 2021 and would continue in force for a maximum duration of 6 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be carried out between 11<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> November 2021, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time, then the Order may have effect at other times within the maximum duration of 6 months.
