Height and size restrictions apply for all rides and attractions. Helper goes free of charge. Guests must show evidence of their disability, e.g. a blue/orange badge or similar, (as stated on their website.) Present your ticket and disability proof at the turnstile gates to receive your free helper ticket. In addition, an extra helper can enter at a concessionary rate, providing the second is required to assist you on to specific rides and attractions. Wheelchair-users should use the gates to the far left and right of the turnstiles.

On the day, head to the Pre Booked Ticket Collection window and present your supporting document ie, DLA, Personal Independence Payment letter or a current and valid Blue Badge (your supporting documents must be dated within the last 6 months,) and ask for your free carer ticket. An additional needs form can be completed online to obtain a ride access pass. Please note, further documentation is required for this, ie, a letter from your doctor, a diagnosis letter or any letter from an official organisation or hospital is required to obtain it.

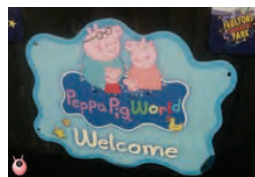

About the CEA Card

The CEA Card is a national card scheme developed for UK cinemas by the UK Cinema Association (UKCA), formerly the Cinema Exhibitors' Association (CEA).



The scheme was introduced in 2004 and is one of the ways for participating cinemas to ensure they make reasonable adjustments for disabled guests when they go to the cinema; in particular it ensures a complimentary ticket for someone to go with them. Approximately 90% of cinemas in the UK accept the CEA Card.

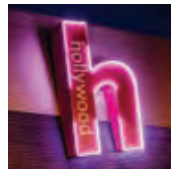

To qualify you must be in receipt of any of the following: Middle or higher rate of the Disability Living Allowance. Standard or enhanced rate of daily living component of the Personal Independence Payment. Enhanced rate of the mobility component of the Personal Independence Payment. Severe Disablement Allowance, the Employment and Support Allowance or the Attendance Allowance; A specialist personal letter from the hospital to confirm that the person is in receipt of support services.

NB: Receipt of an orange/Blue badge will not be considered sufficient proof of disability. When applying, proof of disability must be valid within the last year from the date of application and be attached with your completed application form.

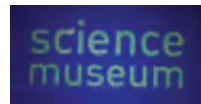
