STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ABOVE ORDERS

A review of parking, waiting and loading restrictions in West Norwood Town Centre has been carried out.

The proposed Orders would introduce new “at any time” waiting restrictions (double yellow lines) and loading restrictions (single kerb markings) between 7 am and 10 am and 4 pm and 7 pm on Mondays to Saturdays in parts of Bloom Grove, Canterbury Grove, Chatsworth Way, Chestnut Road, Dalton Street, Dunbar Street, Hannen Road, Knight’s Hill, Lancaster Avenue, Lansdowne Hill, Norwood High Street, Robson Road and York Hill.

The proposals would also amend various limited free time parking places, disabled persons parking places and provide new loading places in or close to those roads.

The proposed amendments aim to:

- remove obstructive and illegal parking to improve pedestrian safety, bus reliability and traffic flow.
- simplify the operation and restrictions on the ‘free’ parking bays making it easier for users to understand
- provide dedicated loading facilities for businesses and customers

It is hoped that these improvements will, not only continue to ensure that West Norwood town centre remains a vital and viable hub for the local community but also, through the reduction in congestion and better traffic flow, realise a decrease in the level of vehicle emissions contributing to a better air quality for the area
