Dear Resident/Business

The purpose of this leaflet is to let you know the outcome of the Stage 1 Consultation carried out between 27 September & 24 October 2021 on proposals to introduce a controlled parking zone (CPZ) in your area.

The results of the consultation along with your views and officers' recommendations were presented to the Cabinet Members before making the final decision. Due to the results of consultation the Council has decided to <u>not</u> proceed with a statutory consultation on the proposed measures.

The consultation resulted in a total of 541 replies out of the 2886 properties consulted, representing a response rate of 18.7%. The following is a summary of those responses.

- Overall, a majority of 71.8% of all respondents felt that they **did not** have a parking problem in their road, as opposed to 19.2% who felt that they do.
- A majority of 80% **did not** support a CPZ, compared with 14% who do.
