**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE BONDWAY**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable telecommunication works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Bondway which lies between Parry Street and approximately 11 metres south of Parry Street.
2. An alternative route for vehicles would be available via Parry Street and Wandsworth Road.
3. The ban on vehicles entering Bondway would not apply to any vehicle requiring access to or egress from properties or premises in Bondway or Miles Street, accessible only from Bondway, providing that vehicle does not interfere with or disrupt the works.
4. The above road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
5. The Order would come into force on 5<sup>th</sup> January 2022 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect from 5<sup>th</sup> January 2022 for 2 days, but if the works cannot be carried out or be completed during that time then the Order may have effect on a subsequent day or days within the maximum duration of 2 months.
