ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS BRAXTED PARK

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Telecommunication repair and maintenance to be carried out in Braxted Park, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering or waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading a vehicle) in that length of Braxted Park which lies between Baldry Gardens and No. 11 Braxted Park.
2. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Streatham Common South, Copley Park and Baldry Gardens and vice versa.
4. The Order would come into force on 7th January 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 6 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect from 7th January 2022 for 5 days but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the order may have effect at subsequent times within that maximum duration of 6 months.
