The Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Lambeth (Clapham “C”) (Parking Places) (No. *) Order 2022 and shall come into force on * 2022.

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order “the Order of 2010” means the Lambeth (Clapham “C”) (Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 2010(b).

(2) Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2010 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

(3) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

Revocation of designation of parking places

3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, the designation by the Order of 2010 of the parking place numbered 494 therein, the Lambeth (Clapham “C”) Parking Places (No. *) Order 2003(c) of the parking places numbered 5 and 6 therein, the Lambeth (Clapham “C”) Parking Places (No. *) Order 2011(d) of the parking place numbered 602 therein, are hereby revoked.

Designation of parking place and application of the Order of 2010 thereto

4. (1) The area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in column 2 of the Schedules 1 and 2 to this Order and bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway and on the other sides by a white line marking is designated as a parking place.

(2) The reference in this Article to a white line marking shall be construed as a reference to the white line marking (either broken or continuous) provided for in Schedule 7 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016(a) or, if applicable, authorised by the Secretary of State by virtue of section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

(3) The provisions of the Order of 2010 (other than Articles 3, 16 and 41) shall apply to the area designated as a parking place by this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a parking place included a reference to the area designated as a parking place by this Order and as if any reference to Schedule 12 to the Order of 2010 included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.

Placing of traffic signs, etc.

5. The Council shall:-

(a) place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of the parking place referred to in the Schedules to this Order;

(b) place and maintain in or in the vicinity of the parking place referred to in the Schedules to this Order traffic signs indicating that such parking place may be used during the permitted hours for the leaving only of the vehicles specified in Article 4(3) of the Order of 2010; and

(c) carry out such other work as is reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of the parking place referred to in the Schedules to this Order.

SCHEDULE 1

IN RELATION TO A PARKING PLACE REFERRED TO IN THIS SCHEDULE THE EXPRESSION "PERMITTED HOURS" MEANS THE PERIOD BETWEEN 9.30 A.M AND 5.30 P.M. ON MONDAYS TO FRIDAYS INCLUSIVE, ANY SUCH DAY NOT BEING CHRISTMAS DAY, GOOD FRIDAY OR A BANK HOLIDAY.

PARKING PLACES IN WHICH A VEHICLE MAY BE LEFT DURING THE PERMITTED HOURS PROVIDING THE VEHICLE DISPLAYS EITHER A VALID RESIDENTS' PERMIT, OR A VALID VISITORS' PERMIT OR A VALID TRADE PERMIT ISSUED IN RESPECT OF THAT VEHICLE UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDER, OR A VALID RESIDENTS' PERMIT, OR A VALID VISITORS' PERMIT ISSUED IN RESPECT OF THAT VEHICLE UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE WANDSWORTH ORDER.

SCHEDULE 2

IN RELATION TO A PARKING PLACE REFERRED TO IN THIS SCHEDULE THE EXPRESSION "PERMITTED HOURS" MEANS THE PERIOD BETWEEN 8.30 A.M AND 6.30 P.M. ON MONDAYS TO FRIDAYS INCLUSIVE, ANY SUCH DAY NOT BEING CHRISTMAS DAY, GOOD FRIDAY OR A BANK HOLIDAY.

PARKING PLACES IN WHICH A VEHICLE MAY BE LEFT DURING THE PERMITTED HOURS PROVIDING THE VEHICLE DISPLAYS EITHER A VALID TICKET (AND IS LEFT FOR A MAXIMUM OF FOUR HOURS), A VALID LAMBETH RESIDENTS' PERMIT, A VALID ALMBETH BUSINESS PERMIT, A VALID LAMBETH CAR CLUB PERMIT, A VALID LAMBETH VISITOR'S PERMIT, A VALID LAMBETH TEACHER'S PERMIT, A VALID TRADE PERMIT OR A VALID PRIMARY CARE TRUST PERMIT ISSUED OR VALIDATED IN RESPECT OF THAT VEHICLE.
