CONTINUATION OF TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS IN ATLANTIC ROAD, DALBERG ROAD, EFFRA ROAD, JELF ROAD, RAILTON ROAD AND ST MATTHEWS ROAD AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS IN PARTS OF COLDHARBOUR LANE AND SHAKESPEARE ROAD, INCLUDING THE REMOVAL OF PARKING SPACE IN SHAKESPEARE ROAD, ORIGINALLY TRIALLED AS AN EXPERIMENT

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR MAKING THE ABOVE ORDERS

The Orders will continue to ban vehicles, except pedal cycles, from entering certain roads and from using various roads as through roads in the Brixton area and ban waiting by vehicles at any time in parts of Coldharbour Lane and Shakespeare Road, including the removal of part of a resident's parking place in Shakespeare Road.

The Orders are intended to reduce through vehicular traffic in the Brixton area so as to improve road safety, reduce air pollution and encourage active travel on foot or cycle. The waiting restrictions in a length of Coldharbour Lane are needed to provide suitable turning space for buses exiting from Somerleyton Road and the removal of parking space and ban on waiting by vehicles in Shakespeare Road is necessary to prevent parking within the part of Shakespeare Road that motor vehicles should not enter.
