ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS ELMS CRESCENT AND ELMS ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable sewer repair works to be carried out by Thames Water, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering the following lengths of roads:-

- (a) **Elms Crescent**, which lies between the party wall of Nos. 97 and 99 Elms Crescent and the party wall of Nos. 105 and 107 Elms Crescent;
- (b) **Elms Road**, which lies between the western kerb-line of Elms Crescent and the party wall of Nos. 81 and 83 Elms Road.

2. The alternative routes for affected vehicles would be via: (a) Franconia Road, Abbeville Road and Hambalt Road and vice versa; (b) Elms Road, Abbeville Road and Hambalt Road; and (c) Elms Road, Abbeville Road and Franconia Road.

3. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 9th May 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 6 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be carried out between 9th May 2022 and 27th May 2022, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 6 months.
