PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE LAYOUT OF PARKING PLACES IN ELMS CRESCENT AND WYATT PARK ROAD

[NOTE: This Notice is about Orders to formally remove certain parking spaces in Elms Crescent and Wyatt Park Road to accommodate the installation of new vehicle crossovers (dropped kerbs).

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth (the "Council") on the 30th March 2022 made The Lambeth (Clapham "L") (Parking Places) (No.2) Order 2022 and The Lambeth (Streatham Hill East "M") (Parking Places) (No. 2) Order 2022 under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2. The general effect of the Orders which will come into force on 4th April 2022 will be to remove a length of parking space at each of the following locations and replace it with single yellow line waiting restrictions that will apply at the same time as the controlled parking zone operates in that road (the type of parking space is specified in brackets):-

- (1) **Elms Crescent**, the south-east side, outside No. 161 (resident's parking space);
- (2) **Elms Crescent**, the south-east side, outside No. 165 (resident's parking space);
- (3) **Wyatt Park Road**, the south-west side, outside No. 62 (shared use parking space).

3. The proposed removal of parking spaces at the locations described in paragraph 2 above is necessary to allow vehicle crossovers (dropped kerbs) to be installed, so to enable vehicular access to properties.

6. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders are made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
