ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS – HEATHDENE ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable water main replacement works by Thames Water to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, subject to the agreement of Transport for London, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily:-
 - (a) impose a one-way traffic system in the entire length of Heathdene Road, in a south-westerly direction (towards Streatham High Road);
 - (b) ban vehicles from waiting (including waiting for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) in the entire length of Heathdene Road.

2. An alternative route would be available for vehicles affected by the bans described in paragraph 1(a) above via (a) Streatham High Road, Hilldown Road and Fontaine Road; or (b) Streatham High Road, Green Lane, Strathbrook Road and Fontaine Road.

3. It is anticipated that the restrictions referred to in paragraph 1 above would be carried out in phases so that the Order would not apply to the whole length of road in the above paragraph at any one time. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 11th April 2022 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 6 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the bans would only apply between 11th April 2022 and 22nd May 2022 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 6 months.
