**AMENDMENTS TO PARKING PLACE LAYOUT AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS
IN KENNINGTON OVAL**

[NOTE: This Notice is about amendments to the layout of parking bays and waiting restrictions in Kennington Oval between its junctions with Bowling Green Street and Harleyford Street. A section of the shared use parking place on the west side opposite Bowling Green Street will be removed and replaced with a disabled persons parking place. The shared use parking place on the west side opposite Nos. 1 to 121 Lockwood House will be replaced with a single yellow line waiting restriction that will operate at the current CPZ times, on Monday to Friday, 8.30am to 6.30pm.

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made the Lambeth (Kennington) (Parking Places) (No. 4) Order 2022 and the Lambeth (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No. 4) Order 2022, under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The Orders will come into force on 18th March 2022.

2. The general effect of the Orders will be, in Kennington Oval to:–

- (a) replace 13.2 metres of the existing shared use parking place on the west side of Kennington Oval, located 20.7 metres south of Bowling Green Street with a disabled persons' parking place; and
- (b) replace the existing shared use parking place on the west side of Kennington Oval opposite Nos. 1 to 121 Lockwood House with single yellow line waiting restrictions located between a point 49.4 metres north of its junction with Harleyford Street and a point 33.9 metres south of Bowling Green Street.

5. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders are made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
