### **LOWER MARSH – PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLE ZONE**

(Prescribed Routes) (No. 5) Traffic Order 2022

#### **STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR MAKING THE ABOVE ORDER**

The Order is necessary to make permanent the temporary measures implemented in August 2020, which created a pedestrian and cycle zone in Lower Marsh to generate the necessary space to facilitate outdoor seating and trading. The amendment in Frazier Street accommodates access and facilitates loading for vehicles.

The Temporary Traffic Orders were implemented in accordance with the Transport Strategy Programme and the Mayor of London's Streetspace for London Programme. The resulting reallocation of space on Lower Marsh and Frazier Street is intended to support a mode shift towards active travel and a locally led economic recovery from the Covid-19 pandemic.

The continuation of these measures creates a better walking and cycling route, promoting the Council's Healthy Route network.
