ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS – FARQUHAR ROAD, JASPER ROAD AND WESTOW HILL

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, subject to the agreement of the London Borough of Southwark, intend to make an Order the general effect of which would be at certain times to:-

- (a) ban vehicles proceeding:-
 - (i) in the south to north arm of the southern side of Jasper Road from turning right into the the north-west to south-east arm of Jasper Road (outside Nos. 31 and 33 Farquhar Road)
 - (ii) in Westow Hill from turning left into Jasper Road;
 - (iii) in Farquhar Road from turning left into the northern arm of Jasper Road;
 - (iv) in Farquhar Road from turning right into the northern arm of Jasper Road;
- (b) ban waiting (including waiting for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) by vehicles in that length of Farquhar Road which lies between a point 20 metres north of the northern kerb-line of the northern arm of Jasper Road and a point 20 metres south-west of the south-western kerb-line of the southern arm of Jasper Road;
- (c) impose a one-way traffic system in that length of the east to north-west and then south-west to north-east arms of Jasper Road, which lies between the south-western kerb-line of the southern arm of Farquahar Road and the northern kerb-line of the northern arm of Farquahar Road, in a north-westerly and then north-easterly direction.

2. The restrictions are necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public caused by an increase in traffic and parked vehicles at certain times in the vicinity of Crystal Palace Park while the Wireless Festival event is taking place at Crystal Palace Park.

3. The Order would come into force on 1st July 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 3 days. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
