TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - CHAPEL ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water repair and maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that section of Chapel Road which lies between the eastern flank wall of No. 10 Chapel Road and the eastern kerb-line of Knights Hill.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Norwood High Street, Rothschild Street, Knight's Hill and vice versa.
- 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 5th October 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 6 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be completed within 2 days, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time then the Order may have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 6 months.
