**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14**

**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS FOR  
CARRIAGEWAY RESURFACING AND PLANNED MAINTENANCE**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable carriageway resurfacing and planned maintenance to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intends to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily:-

- (a) ban vehicles in that length of Frazier Street which lies between Bayliss Road and Pearman Street;
- (b) ban vehicles waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading a vehicle) in that length of Gipsy Hill which lies between Cawnpore Street and Beacondale Road;
- (c) suspend the ban on motor vehicles entering Shakespeare Road at its junction with Mayall Road whenever resurfacing or maintenance works are being carried out in Shakespeare Road.

2. The alternative route for vehicles affected by the 1(a) would be diverted via adjacent streets as indicated by traffic signs.

3. The ban and suspension would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing and covering of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The order would come into force on 21<sup>st</sup> September and would continue for a maximum duration of 12 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier.
