TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - LEIGHAM VALE

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water repair and maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from traveling in a north-western direction in that section of Leigham Vale which lies between the north-western kerb-line of Knolly's Road and a point opposite the north-westernmost building wall of Nos. 1 to 28 Pembroke Lodge, Leigham Court Road.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be provided via Norwood Road, York Hill, Knolly's Road and Leigham Vale.
- 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 7th November 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 6 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be carried out between 7th November 2022 and 8th November 2022, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order would also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 6 months.
