ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS BLOOM GROVE

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable cycle hangar installation works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban any vehicle from waiting, including waiting for the purposes of loading / unloading, in Bloom Grove, the north-west side, between the common boundary of Nos. 14 and 15 Bloom Grove and the common boundary of Nos. 17 and 18 Bloom Grove.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would not be required.
- 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 1st December 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would take one day to complete, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order would also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 1 month.
