## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

## **TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - CASEWICK ROAD & TIVOLI ROAD**

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable repair and maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles and pedestrians from entering:
  - (a) that section of Tivoli Road which lies between the common boundary of Nos. 139 and 141 Tivoli Road and the common boundary of Nos. 133 and 135 Tivoli Road.
  - (b) that section of Casewick Road which lies between Nos. 40/42 and Nos. 48/50 Casewick Road.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be provided via (i) Furneaux Avenue, Beulah Hill and Crown Dale; and (ii) Thornlaw Road and Casewick Road.
- 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 31st October 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the order will only remain in force for up to 2 months.
