TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS HEATHDENE ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water mains replacement works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, with the agreement of Transport for London, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from:
 - (a) travelling in a north-easterly direction in Heathdene Road, between with the northeastern kerb-line of Streatham High Road and the south-western kerb-line of Fontaine Road; and
 - (b) stopping, parking and waiting (including for the purposes of loading and unloading) in Heathdene Road, between the north-eastern kerb-line of Streatham High Road and the south-western kerb-line of Fontaine Road.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be provided via (i) Streatham High Road, Hilldown Road and Fontaine Road, and (ii) Streatham High Road, Green Lane, Strathbrook Road and Fontaine Road.
- 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 17th October 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be carried out between 17th October 2022 and the 12th January 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order would also have effect on subsequent dates
