TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - KILLYON ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water repair and maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering Killyon Road between the common boundary of Nos. 52 and 54 Killyon Road and the common boundary of Nos. 60 and 62 Killyon Road.
- 2. Whilst this Order continues in force, the one way working in Killyon Road would be suspended.
- 3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Wandsworth Road, Albion Avenue and Larkhall Rise.
- 4. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 5. The Order would come into force on 17th October 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 6 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be carried out between 17th October 2022 and the 4th November 2022, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order would also have effect on subsequent dates.
