ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS TYERS STREET

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable utility infrastructure installation works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering in that length of Tyers Street which lies between Black Prince Road and a point 22 metres south-west of Black Prince Road.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Jonathan Street, Vauxhall Street and Black Prince Road and vice versa.
- 3. Whenever the ban referred in paragraph 1 above applies the one-way system in Tyers Street between Jonathan Street and Black Prince Road would be suspended to enable vehicles to gain access to properties and premises only accessible from that length of Tyers Street, provided they do not enter the works area.
- 4. The ban and suspension of the one-way system would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing and/or covering of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 5. The Order would come into force on 30th November 2022 for a maximum duration of 6 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works will only have effect from 30th November 2022 for 3 days, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order would also have effect on subsequent dates and times within the maximum period of 6 months.
