ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - WESTERN ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable UKPN duct installation works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from:
 - (a) entering that section of Western Road, which lies between the north-eastern kerb-line of Gresham Road and a point opposite the common boundary of Nos. 2 and 3 Sisulu Place: and
 - (b) travelling in a direction other than from south-east to north-west, in Hinton Road, between a point 80 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerb-line of Coldharbour Lane and that kerb-line.
- 2. Whilst this Order continues in force, the one way working in Western Road would be suspended and two way traffic would be permitted between the Greham Road and St James Crescent .
- 3. Alternative routes for affected motor vehicles would be available via Gresham Road, Wiltshire Road, Fyfield Road and St James's Crescent, and vice versa for cyclists.
- 4. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 5. The Order would come into force on 7th November 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 6 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be carried out between 7th November 2022 and 18th November 2022, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order would also have effect on subsequent dates during the within the maximum period of 6 months.
